Course Content:

This one-day course has been developed to help members respond to the increasing demand for them to react immediately, effectively and quickly to a developing situation. This course shows them how to get the first pictures back to the newsroom and how to film and edit those shots properly using an android phone or device.

It emphasises the need for devices to be used as a first response and to take those shots in the absence of any other media person.

Programme

- improvising 'steadicam' kit
- using a plug-in microphone to improve audio
- interviewing tips for 'Android devices'
- best use of light
- sketching 'storyboards' for editing

What you should bring with you:

Your own Android device. Learners should download *windows movie maker* to their device prior to attending the course. Your device charger.
